PRIVILEGE OF THE FLOOR

At each Regular and Special meeting, the privilege of the floor shall be offered to any person in attendance at such meeting.

Each person wishing to exercise the privilege of the floor shall be allowed five minutes in which to address those matters of interest. Should the matter to be presented require more than five minutes, the President may require a summary statement to be prepared and distributed to the Board prior to the meeting at which the presentation is to be made.

The amount of total time to be spent in extending the privilege of the floor to persons in attendance shall be limited to fifteen minutes, except that the Board may vote to extend same.
