COMPUTER TECHNOLOGY ADVISORY COMMITTEE

The BOCES recognizes that the field of Computer Information Technology for school purposes is both rapidly developing and highly complex. In servicing the requirements of the public schools within the region served by the Regional Information Center, the BOCES must rely heavily upon the center director for background information and recommendations upon which to base decisions relating to center operations.

At the same time, the BOCES acknowledges the fact that the field is marked by wide differences of honest expert opinion concerning technology and its implementation in services to the user community. The BOCES, therefore, wishes to insure against possible parochialism in outlook and to assure broad perspective in its decision making.

To this end, the BOCES may appoint as needed an Ad Hoc panel of three or more objective experts in the field of Technology, who are not subject to conflict of interest; to provide a background of information concerning those specific policy matters in which a majority of the Board members feel additional data beyond that provided would be helpful.
