PUBLIC PARTICIPATION - BUDGET DEVELOPMENT

The BOCES Board considers that there should be opportunity for component Boards of Education, professionals, parents and various staff members to react to budget proposals and to have other input possibilities.

Accordingly, the Board intends that those persons having either professional or personal interest and expertise be afforded opportunities to participate in the budget development process prior to final adoption.

These opportunities might include making preliminary budgets available for review and comment, organizing group discussions of those specifically interested in particular programs, public consideration and discussion of new program elements, and the development and dissemination of simple, readily understandable budget materials.
