DRUG FREE WORKPLACE

No person may use, possess, sell, or distribute alcohol or any illicit substance, nor may they use or possess drug paraphernalia on BOCES grounds or at BOCES-sponsored events, except such drugs as prescribed by a physician. Examples of illicit substances are inhalants, marijuana, cocaine, LSD, PCP, amphetamines, heroin, steroids, look-alikes, and any of those substances commonly referred to as "designer drugs." The inappropriate use of prescription and over-the-counter drugs shall be prohibited.

The following person shall be prohibited from entering BOCES grounds or BOCES-sponsored events: any person exhibiting behavior, conduct, or personal or physical characteristics indicative of having used or consumed alcohol or other such substances, or any person who BOCES personnel have reasonable grounds to suspect has used alcohol or other such substances.

Additionally, any person engaged in work in connection with a Federal grant shall comply with the conditions found in Administrative Procedure 016. This procedure also contains a copy of the directive to students regarding alcohol and drug abuse prevention.
