PRESIDENT OF THE BOARD

Responsibilities

The President shall perform the duties associated with the office of President of a BOCES organized under the education laws of New York State. He/she shall have the power to sign and execute all contracts, agreements, or other obligations in the name of the BOCES, and shall exercise such other powers as may be assigned to him/her by the BOCES. The President shall preside at all regular and special meetings of the Board.

The President shall appoint committees of the Board and shall determine the duties and areas of responsibilities of these several committees. He/she shall coordinate the work of the officers and committees of the Board.

The President shall be an ex-officio member of all committees of the BOCES.

The President shall, in conjunction with the District Superintendent of Schools, have responsibility for the agenda of any board meeting, regular or special. Any member of the Board may submit an agenda item to the District Superintendent or to the President for inclusion on the agenda.

The President shall work to insure an orderly transition from one year to the next and to provide for the orientation of new Board members.
